

Chelmsford North East Bypass update



We are pleased to announce the Chelmsford North East Bypass project is moving into the next stage of development.

As part of the this you may see more activity in the proposed scheme area as we undertake archaeological investigations to help inform and develop the detailed design for the bypass.

This will involve the excavation of several evaluation

trenches measuring 30x1.8m to assess the potential for any archaeological remains and any impact the scheme would have on them.

We will carry out the archaeological investigations during the day and over the next three months.

This work will ultimately support the planning application for the new bypass which is due to be submitted later this year.
