JW informed Cllr Henry that the Vehicle activated sign (VAS) along Whitmore Way LBAS182021 will have to be replaced rather than fixed.

JW stated that all 20's plenty sites given to her by the panel are currently within validation therefore updates are to be given in due course.

JW provided images of locations for the proposed bus shelters for the Panel.

6. 2019/20 Casualty Reduction Scheme Briefing

Senior Road Safety Engineer IH gave an introduction on the work he carries out and the criteria that needs to be met to clarify as a casualty reduction site.

David Gollop Design Manager explained to the panel that all evidence of incidents are provided through the police records therefore only present when they have been reported by the relevant authorities. This is because Essex County Council's focus is 'Personal injury accidents' therefore this is the only data that is provided to us for investigation.

Following this information Councillors would like to see further information to be looked at as they felt that incidents occur on a daily basis causing damage to cars however aren't reported.

Cllr Hillier explained that those incidents that aren't being reported and leaving damage on the highway which is causing the Parish to pick up on the cost in the area. It was also explained that because these incidents aren't being reported it is causing anomalies within the data.

JW then explained to the panel that when an accident occurs, if evidence can be provided of the incident the costs can be claimed through 'Green Claims' therefore the parish wouldn't have to pick up the costs if they are able to prove who the perpetrator was as this would be claimed through their insurance company.

2018/2019 Casualty Reduction sites

Site 1: B1464 London Road Jw Pound Lane.

IH explained that the feasibility has taken place and are looking to commission a design only in the first instance to look at the remedial measures of Lane 1 becoming signalised for ahead movement only and Lane 2 separately signalled for the right turn movement only therefore ensuring that Vehicles on London Road eastbound are held on red whilst vehicles turn right into Pound Lane.

Site 2: A176 Nethermayne / BP Service Station IH explained the collision data and the measures we are looking to implement thus being extending the central island along A176 Nethermayne to prevent users turning right out the B.P station to travel North along the A176 onto Roundacre roundabout, this option was discussed with B.P garage to which they objected further discussions were to be held with B.P services to determine whether they can reverse the entry/exit to the BP station but the Cllrs detailed

they can reverse the entry/exit to the BP station but the Cllrs detailed B.P would likely be rejected this option. Instead the Cllrs unanimously agreed that the extension of the central island further south was the appropriate measure. Cllr Buckley added that we should look into the pedestrian movement during the feasibility. A design only will be taken forward for this scheme.

Site 3: A1321 Broadmayne Roundabout Jw B1419 Timerlog Lane & Churchill Avenue

IH explained the collision data and the measures that we are looking to implement. It was suggested that existing highway screening / hedgerow should be terminated 15m in advance of the give way lines to improve visibility. Overgrown vegetation is cut back on the nearside of the carriageway to improve forward visibility. Existing furniture and signing to be repaired or replaced with yellow backed versions with 'reduce speed now' supplementary plates. Review of the existing speed limit repeater signs to be undertaken and additional signs to be provided where appropriate. Also recommended that the worn road markings should be refreshed.

IH explained to Cllr Buckley why bar markings cannot be implemented.

Cllr Hillier questioned if the speed could be reduced to 40 mph before the roundabout up until the next roundabout, IH explained that the houses are set back from the junction and the route fits the criteria of a radial distributor which would not meet the guidance set out in the Essex Speed Management Strategy.

Cllr Smith felt that we should contact 'swans' to investigate any S106 money available/contribution to help with the development.

Site 4: A127 Eastbound Off-slip Jw B148 RAB, Dunton IH explained the collision data that has been supported by camera survey footage to help understand why cyclists were being hit going towards Hernongate. It was highlighted that we have an 'approach screening' be provided to the offside of the eastbound to a point of 15m in advance of the giveaway line along with removing all vegetation from the area top the offside pf the off-slip with 15m of the giveaway signs.

Cllr Hillier explained this is a bad junction for visibility saying that it is difficult to see the cyclists therefore wouldn't believe this was driver error.

Cllr Buckley felt that cyclists should be given education within the area, Ford Cycling scheme is in the area and may need approaching to educate the cyclists with wearing reflective clothing and using lights to be visible to drivers.

DG explained that the screening could be investigated and we would look into the education of cyclists.

Site 5: A176 Uppermayne Roundabout Junction with A176 Noak Hill Road, South Wash Road & A127 Eastbound Off-Slip, Noak Bridge. IH explained the collision data and the remedial measures we are looking to investigate. Looking for design only to investigate the potential re-alignment of the northbound and east bound approaches to the roundabout, Along with a Topographical survey of the area as part of the design. Chevron signage on the roundabout should be reviewed/amended as a part of the approach alignment. Carriageway will also need to be resurfaced on the eastbound and northbound approaches to the roundabout as apart for the scheme implementation.

Cllr Hillier explains the slips roads could be a contributing factor due to the bad decision. Cllr Buckley understood that these were meant to be wider and suggests we look into signage and lining of the carriageway.

7. Approved Works Programme

JW informs the panel that everything marked green has been completed.

Cllr Smith requested an update on the delivery date on LBAS172024 New Avenue, Playground Warning Signs JW indicated that the scheme will hopefully be installed by the end of this financial year.

LBAS172034 Radford Way, Billericay is currently in target costing.

LBAS182006 Coppice Lane, Wickford is also in target costing.

LBAS183005 Malyons Place Dropped Kerbs has been completed Cllr Reid would like the rangers to visit the site to clear the debris along the pavement

JW informed the panel that a number of schemes are to be completed by the direct delivery team and will therefore be cheaper than what is presented in the Panel.

BASILDON LOCAL HIGHWAY PANEL - 25th MARCH 2019 REPORT 2 – POTENTIAL CAPITAL SCHEMES

The following Potential Scheme List identifies all of the scheme requests which have been received for the consideration of the Basildon Local Highways Panel. Members are asked to review these schemes, finalise their scheme funding recommendations for the schemes they wish to see delivered in 2019/20 and remove any schemes the Panel would not wish to consider for future funding.

The Direct Delivery Gang in 18/19 achieved cost savings on smaller works for the Local Highway Panels. We would like the panel to consider capitalising on this for 19/20 by recommending to commission 10% or less of its budget to cover smaller works requested by the County Member which could be delivered quickly by the direct delivery team. We aim to, with your permission, deliver these schemes within a 3-6 month period. To do this we ask the panels' permission to agree in advance any scheme which falls under the direct delivery category and for this to be delivered under Chairman's approval.
