	There were none.					



5	Casualty Reduction 2021/22				
	Ian Henderson provided an update explaining what data is used and analysed for the Casualty Reduction Cluster Report, highlighting that the data is submitted from the police reports and looks at any accidents where there was fatally, seriously or slightly injured and this data is plotted geographically with a cluster analysis completed yearly.				
	From the report there was one location highlighted as concern, Kits Hill, B1012 junction joining the B1010. The issues will be stripped back to see what can be done from an engineering perspective. The first phase will be the initial feasibility study and will include a video survey over a couple if days, the days times for this survey can be steered by members of this group to advise.				
	Members welcomed the review of this junction with urgency.				
	Further sites were raised as concerns, members were advised to submit these to Ian Henderson who would look into the data held relating to these.				
	Sonia Church also offered members the chance for one to one meetings outside of the LHP to answer any questions concerns not relating to schemes discussed at this meeting.

	The Highways Liaison Officer drew Members attention to page 6 of the report.

	Members noted those schemes completed and the estimated completion timeline for the remainder.				
	Item 1 - B1018 Langford Road, Wickham Bishops – Signing – The Highways Liaison Officer advised that the scheme had been passed to the delivery team for installation.				



	Item 3 - Woodrolfe Road, Tollesbury - Surface Improvements – This	
	scheme has been passed to an engineer.	
	Item 5 - A414, Maldon Road, Woodham Mortimer - Speed Reduction. – A CMA had been written for Councillor Bentley as the scheme had received objections. The objections relate to residents requesting a lower speed limit than what is proposed.	
	Item 6 - Southend Road and B1010, Burnham Road, Hazeleigh - Amendments to speed limit and gateways – This scheme has been passed to the direct delivery team with an aim to deliver w/c 14.12.20.	
	Item 7 - Limebrook Way j/w Mundon Road/Wantz Road, Maldon – Signing – The Highways Liaison Officer advised that this scheme had been passed to the direct delivery team for installation.	
	Item 10 - Maypole Road, j/w Back Lane, Great Totham - Casualty Reduction scheme – The Highways Liaison Officer advised that this scheme has been passed to the engineers.	
	Item 11 - Witham Road, Wickham Bishops - Junction and signing improvements – A trial hole was required to be undertaken to determine the depth of the asbestos water pipe.	
	Item 12 - Tiptree Road, Wickham Bishops – Footway – The Highways Liaison Officer advised that this has not been scheduled yet but under the impression that it will go to the same engineer that undertook the feasibility study.

Finally, white was where a request has been received and was in the initial validation process.

The Highways Liaison Officer drew the Panel's attention to page 9 of the report.

The Highways Liaison Officer noted that there are many schemes in various stages of assessment and whilst usually at the December meeting we evaluate those and move them to the funded stage for the forthcoming year, there are not many that will be able to progress today.

Traffic Management

<u>Item 1 - Blackhouse Farm Cottages, Steeple Road, St Lawrence –</u> The site is currently under investigation and a meeting is to be arranged with a County member and residents. Difficult for officers to have contact with residents, this should be arranged via the Parish Council.

<u>Item 5 - Mill Lane j/w Buckingham Street, Tolleshunt Major –</u> Item to remain on the list. There is a planning application due to be determined next week, the outcome of this should be considered first.

<u>Item 6 - Woodham Road/The Street, Stow Maries - Traffic</u> <u>management improvements –</u> Although the feasibility study has recommended not to proceed, Parish residents are not happy with the decision and Councillor Channer has asked for this to remain on the list.

<u>Item 7 - Fambridge Road, Maldon (Limebrook Way RAB to Royal Oak</u> <u>P/H) – Footpath –</u> The Highways Liaison Officer agreed that this should remain on the list and will make contact with the land owner.

Councillor Stamp and Councillor Channer gave their apologies and left the meeting, noting that Councillor Channer requested that any schemes within her ward remain on the list until the next meeting.

<u>Item 8 - Steeple Road, Mayland –</u> Councillor Pratt advised that this scheme aligns to another issue in Althorne. Sonia Church informed the LHP group that Councillor Bentley has instructed Essex County Highways to review the speed management strategy and it would be beneficial to leave anything speed related on the list until the policy has been approved. <u>Item 10 - Limebrook Way, Maldon - Speed reduction –</u> A surgery with Councillor Bentley is due to be held to include looking at a crossing across the A414. Therefore, this should remain on the list.

<u>Item 16 - Queen Street, Southminster – TMI –</u>A speeding survey has been undertaken and the report indicates good compliance. Whilst there are concerns from members that they do not necessarily agree with the results, it was agreed that this should be removed from the list based on the results from the survey.

<u>Item 17 - Wood Road, Heybridge –</u> This scheme has now turned green. It has been agreed to undertake some survey work into 20 mph speeding limits, the cost of this would be £5,000 and initial surveys and basic investigations could be completed this year. It was proposed to move this into the funded schemes for this year, this was agreed by members.

<u>Item 18 - Tollesbury Road, Tolleshunt D'arcy –</u> Whilst the validation has recommended proceeding with the speed limit amendments, there are concerns that it will not change driver behaviour. It was agreed that it would remain on the awaiting funding list until the next meeting in March.

Walking

<u>Item 1 - B1010 Chelmsford Road (Spar Lane to Veterinary Practice),</u> <u>Purleigh – Footway –</u> The feasibility study has recommended not to proceed and due to the anticipated high costs members were all in agreement for this to be removed.

<u>Item 4 - Tolleshunt D'arcy Road, Tolleshunt Major - Walkable Verge –</u> The site visit concluded that the existing verge areas measures 0.8mm in places and the minimum width for a walkable verge can be 1.2mm, therefore making this unachievable. Members were therefore in agreement for this to be removed.

<u>Item 6 - Holloway Road, Heybridge –</u> Further information is required regarding pedestrian numbers. Councillor Edwards has further concern around exceeding speed limits and parking along with the crossing improvements. The nature of the problem needs to be ascertained before it is progressed.

Councillor Pratt proposed that this is removed which was agreed by all other members.

	Maldon has the smallest budget, due to them declining the match funding. This may be something that can be looked at in the future, if the match funding is still available. Councillor Durham would be happy to make an approach to Councillor Bentley. Maldon could also consider any projects they feel are viable and approach ECC who may assist towards the project.					
	2 requests have been submitted from Heybridge Parish Council, they will appear on the awaiting funded scheme list for the next meeting. If any are turned down at application stage, the Parish would be informed of this decision.					
	2 requests from Maldon Town Council are maintenance issues and would not progress through LHP.					
	Councillor Siddall asked where the results of a traffic management survey that MP Priti Patel instigated would have gone, having been sent to ECC for analysis. Sonia Church was happy to look into this matter if the details could be sent through to her.					
	Councillor Pratt requested advice and guidance on how to respond to the Althorne residents. Sonia Church would be happy to draft a response to the Parish. Once the policy has been rewritten, it may be that the residents request can be accommodated. It was therefore advised to wait until the policy had been signed off. This was agreed.
