For the purpose of this order the relevant date is 1 April 2020.


The Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Essex shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.

PART I

Modification of Definitive Map

Description of path or way to be upgraded.

- 1) A length of Footpath 13 Birch known as "Caper Lane" is upgraded to Restricted Byway number 40. This commences from Point A on Order Plan 1 in Maldon Road, and continues in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 590 metres to meet Restricted Byway 39 Birch at Point B. From there it continues in a south westerly direction for a distance of 105 metres to meet Mill Lane.. The width of the way incorporates the whole of the land parcel numbered 40 on Order Plan 1a (which is an extract of the 2nd 25" Ordnance Survey edition) and varies between 4 and 10 metres.
- 2) A length of Footpath 16 Birch known as "Straightway" is upgraded to Restricted Byway number 41. This commences from Point A on Order Plan 2 at the County Road north of Layer Breton Heath and continues in a north westerly direction for a distance of 325 metres to point B on Mill Lane. The width of the way is the whole of the parcels numbered 34 and 49 on Plan 2a (which is an extract of the 2nd 25" Ordnance Survey edition) and varies between 3.5 and 9 metres.




The statement for the parish of Birch shall be amended as follows: -



91 NW	13	FP	From Caper Lane (RBWY 40) in generally westerly direction to join Roundbush Road north of Roundbush Farm.
91 NW	16	FP	From Straightway (RBWY 41) at its junction with Mill Lane in a generally westerly direction to the Parish Boundary with Layet Breton, where it continues as Footpath 2


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91 NW	39	RBWY	Form Birch Street westward along School Lane to meet Caper Lane and RBWY 40 Birch. The width of the restricted byway is as depicted on the 1923 Ordnance Survey Map
91 NW	40	RBWY	Caper Lane. Commences at Maldon Road, and continues in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 590 metres to meet Restricted Byway 39 Birch. From there it continues in a south westerly direction for a distance of 105 metres to meet Mill Lane and Footpath 13. The width of the way is the whole of that attached to Plan 1a attached to the order and varies between 4 and 10 metres.
91 NW	41	RBWY	Straightway. Commences at the County Road north of Layer Breton Heath and continues in a north westerly direction for a distance of 325 metres to point B on Mill Lane. The width of the way is the whole of the parcels numbered 34 and 49 on Plan 2a (which is an extract of the 2nd 25" Ordnance Survey edition) and varies between 3.5 and 9 metres.









The Essex County Council have elected pursuant to Paragraph 5(1) of Schedule 15 of the Act that this Order shall have effect as two separate Orders;

The first Order comprising the modification to which objections relate, namely the upgrade of part of Footpath 13 Birch (Caper Lane) to Restricted Byway number 40 as described in Parts 1 and 2 of the Schedule to this Order, and shown for identification purposes on the plans 1 and 2 annexed thereto;

The second Order comprising the remaining modifications, namely the upgrade of part of Footpath 16 Birch (Straightway) to Restricted Byway Number 41, as described in Parts 1 and 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown for identification purposes on the plans 1a and 2a annexed thereto.

The Essex County Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by paragraph 6(1)(a) of Schedule 15 of the Act HEREBY CONFIRM the said second Order.
