This Order is made by Essex County Council (“the authority”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owner of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the lines of the paths should be diverted.

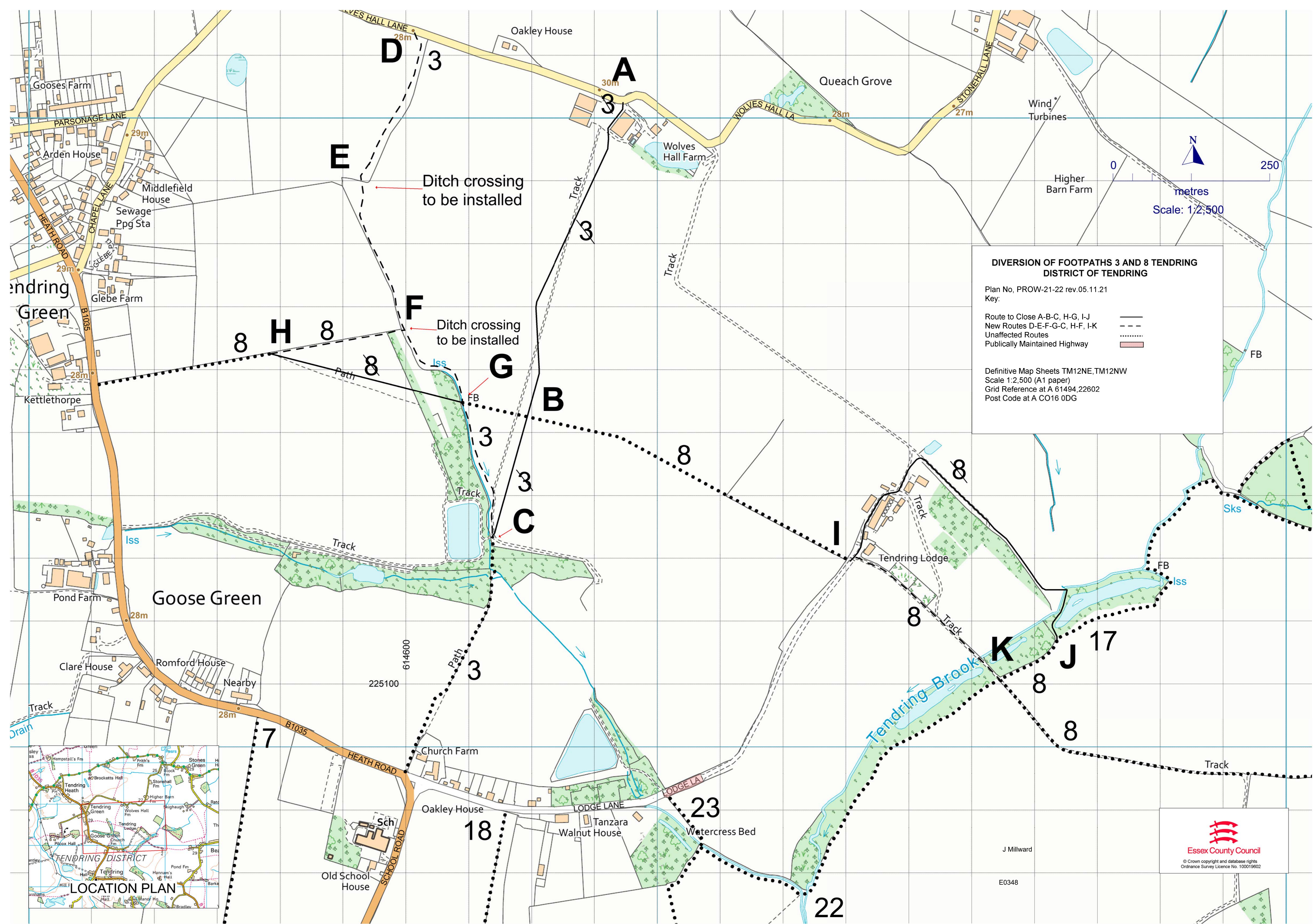
The landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Tendring District Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

**BY THIS ORDER:**

1) The public rights of way over the land situated south of Wolves Hall Lane known as Footpaths 3 and 8 Tendring in the District of Tendring and shown by bold continuous lines on the order map numbered PROW-21-22 rev.05.11.21 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order.

2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be public footpaths over land situated south of Wolves Hall Lane known as Footpaths 3 and 8 Tendring in the District of Tendring as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken lines on the order map numbered PROW-21-22 rev.05.11.21 contained in this order.

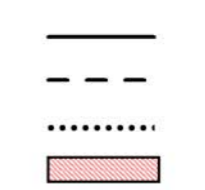

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## SCHEDULE

### (PART 1)

#### DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS OR WAYS

##### Footpath 3 Tendring

A part length of Footpath 3 Tendring of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference 61494, 22602 where it connects to Wolves Hall Lane running between farm buildings then across a field in a south south westerly direction for a distance of approximately 536 metres to point **B** at grid reference 61479, 22552 at the point in the field where it connects to Footpath 8 Tendring then continuing across the field in a south south westerly direction for a final distance of approximately 198 metres to point **C** at grid reference 61473, 22533 at the field edge where it continues unaffected.

##### Footpath 8 Tendring

i) A part length of Footpath 8 Tendring of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from point **H** at grid reference 61438, 22562 where it leaves the field edge running across a field and through a wooded area for a total distance of approximately 312 metres to point **G** at grid reference 61468, 22554 at the field edge.

ii) A further section of Footpath 8 Tendring commencing from point **I** at grid reference 61530, 22529 where it connects to Lodge Lane running in a north easterly direction between farm buildings then in a generally south easterly direction along a field edge and through a wooded area for a total distance of approximately 620 metres to point **J** at grid reference 61563, 22517 at the field edge where it continues unaffected.

(PART 2)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

Footpath 3 Tendring

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken line on the order map commencing at point **D** at grid reference 61461, 22613 where it meets Wolves Hall Lane approximately 350 metres west of the aforementioned point **A** running in a south westerly direction along a field edge on the western side of the field boundary for a distance of approximately 260 metres to point **E** at grid reference 61453, 22590 over a newly installed ditch crossing then continues across a grassed area along the field edge on the eastern side of the field boundary for a further distance of approximately 250 metres to point **F** at grid reference 61459, 22566 where it connects to the diverted route of Footpath 8 Tendring. The path then continues along the field edge for a final distance of approximately 170 metres to the aforementioned point **C** where it continues unaffected.

Footpath 8 Tendring

(i) A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **H** running in an east north easterly direction along the field edge for a total distance of approximately 215 metres to the aforementioned point **F** via a new ditch crossing.

(ii) A further section of Footpath 8 Tendring commencing from the aforementioned point **I** running in a south easterly direction along a track for a total distance of approximately 302 metres to point **K** at grid reference 61554, 22510 where it continues unaffected.
