**NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER  
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024  
FOOTPATHS 20 & 21 HELIONS BUMPSTEAD**

The above order made on 12 January 2024 under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, as shown on the order maps will divert a part length of Footpath 20 Helions Bumpstead of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing at its junction with Footpath 21 Helions Bumpstead running in a north easterly direction across a private garden passing through a hedge boundary for a total distance of approximately 46 metres where it continues unaffected to a footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken line on the order map commencing on a field edge running in a north easterly direction following a field edge boundary for a total distance of approximately 65 metres and to divert a part length of Footpath 21 Helions Bumpstead of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from Sages End Road running across an agricultural field in a south easterly direction for a distance of approximately 220 metres then continuing in an east then north easterly direction through a hedge boundary for a distance of approximately 18 metres to its junction with Footpath 20 Helions Bumpstead to a footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken line on the order map commencing at Sages End Road running along the edge of a field boundary in a south easterly then northerly direction for a total distance of approximately 233 metres and a further part length of Footpath 21 Helions Bumpstead of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from its junction with Footpath 20 Helions Bumpstead running in a north easterly direction across a private garden passing through a hedge boundary then continuing across an agricultural field for a final distance of approximately 248 metres where it continues unaffected to a footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken line on the order map commencing on a field edge running in an easterly direction along the edge of a field boundary for a distance of approximately 197 metres then continuing in a northerly direction along a surfaced driveway for a final distance of approximately 33 metres where it continues unaffected.

Any representations about or objections to the order may be sent in writing to Sarah Potter, Definitive Map Service, Essex County Council, Seax House, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Victoria Road South, Chelmsford CM1 1QH not later than 1 March 2024 Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Essex County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent together with the Order. Any such representation or objections will be taken into account by the Council with the result that they may be made available to the public under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985.
