## NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024 FOOTPATH 12 STAPLEFORD ABBOTTS

On 22 January 2024 Essex County Council confirmed the above orders made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the orders as confirmed as shown on the order maps is to divert a part length of Footpath 12 Stapleford Abbotts of unknown width shown by a bold continuous line on the order map commencing from a private driveway through an electric gate in a north easterly direction passing through a boundary fence for a total distance of approximately 58 metres where it continues unaffected to an alternative route 2 metres in width commencing at the aforementioned start point running along a natural surfaced path in a south easterly direction for a distance of approximately 4 meters then continuing in a north westerly direction for a further distance of approximately 58 metres then continuing in a north westerly direction for a final distance of approximately 5 metres where it continues unaffected.

The alternative route comes into force on 19 February 2024 and the old route shall be stopped up with effect from 26 February 2024, but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 8 February 2024 make an application to the High Court.
