6.	Update from Ian Henderson on Casualty Reduction Schemes 22/23 Ian Henderson, Road Safety Engineering Team Leader updated on the proposed scheme design at Frating crossroads. Following a feasibility study that looked to change the phasing and staging at the location without affecting capacity and the movement of vehicles, it was found that there was enough resilience in the network in terms of the signals to allow a northbound and a southbound phase to run independently, therefore removing the conflict at the junction.  The scheme had been designed and was awaiting costings but it was thought that funding for the scheme could be obtained from a Strategic Development budget or a S106 contribution, which would hopefully cover the entire cost for the						
	scheme.

#### Updates were reported and advice provided on the following schemes:

- LTEN212007 Harwich Road, Great Bromley scheme to remain on the list and to be reconsidered against the new Speed Management Strategy once the housing development has completed. Officers to update wording.
- LTEN212002 Harwich Road, Wrabness Cllr Fairley advised the request was for the signs to be replaced rather than new gateways. Officers to look at and provide cost.
- LTEN212003 Church Road & Wheatsheaf Lane Cllr Fairley advised that further housing was under construction. Church Road, part of Essex way and part of proposed Coastal route. Officer to re-visit scheme. Leave scheme in and change wording.
- LTEN192002 Low Road, Harwich Cllr Henderson reported that the Highway Surgery with the Cabinet Member had not yet gone as there was movement on the development of the housing scheme. Officers undertook to liaise with Chris Stonham.

Cllr Stephenson questioned if scheme LTEN212002 should come under maintenance and Cllr Guglielmi suggested that a position statement was required from the Cabinet Member to clarify the criteria. Cllr Goggin advised that the scrutiny committee for highways panels was looking at that particular issue.

Cllr Henderson suggested that the Cabinet needed to provide a steer to Highways Panels on how to move projects forward in the future whilst linking to the various strategies in place.

Cllr Turner reported that the gateway sign on the B1033 at the boundary to Kirby Cross had been removed two years ago by TDC as it had been deemed as dangerous. Officers undertook to discuss outside of the meeting.

Cllr Turner requested an update on LTEN212023 - Holland Road Frinton-on-Sea - Salt bin installation. Officers undertook to find out and keep Cllr Turner informed.

Members requested that the overall process to install salt bins be reviewed and the Panel updated.

- LTEN183006 Colchester Road, Elmstead Crossing point Cllr Guglielmi advised that the feasibility and design was to be combined and required a further £5,000 in funding to progress and deliver the scheme in 2022/23. The Panel supported the request.
- LTEN165050 Cox's Hill, Lawford Passenger transport improvements.
   Cllr Guglielmi reported that there was no pole; officers undertook to check.
- Cllr Guglielmi questioned why the scheme at Raven's Green was not showing; officers undertook to reinstate the scheme.
- Cllr Goggin thanked officers for attending a meeting with Great Bentley Parish Council, which resulted in a conclusive discussion about what was



needed, some great partnership working, and a good understanding of costs. Cllr Stephenson gueried a submitted PROW scheme to resurface the footpath from Oxford Road to Cotswold Road. Officers undertook to check and report back to Cllr Stephenson. Cllr Honeywood asked about the Zebra crossing on West Road which was in validation. The proposed cycle improvement scheme goes through that area and it was suggested that the scheme could be incorporated into that scheme. Tom Eng Cllr Goggin advised that the LHP meeting was the last one which Tom Eng would be attending in his current capacity, and the first one for James Drabwell in his new role as Highways Liaison Officer. Cllr Goggin thanked Tom for his hard work since taking over from Joe Hazleton in 2018, he had been a pleasure to work with. Cllr Guglielmi thanked Tom and said he had been a breath of fresh air to the Panel, so helpful and nothing too much trouble with good communication and willingness and the Panel had achieved a huge amount because of him. Cllr Platt, on behalf of the whole Panel, thanked Tom and said it had been a pleasure working with him, and wished him every success in his new role. 9.
