|    | The issue regarding the financial contribution from Uttlesford District<br>Council (UDC) was discussed.<br>The Chair said it was about how and when the money was handed<br>over to Essex County Council and a guarantee that UDC money<br>would be spent within the district. He said it came down to a lack of<br>trust between the parties.  |  |
|    | The Highways Liaison Officer said that if the budget was available at<br>the beginning of the year, they would be in a much better position to<br>resource the items and deliver the schemes. |    | The Chief Executive said that he had already spoken to the Interim<br>Place and Public Health Executive from ECC and had agreed that<br>once budgets were set by UDC in February, ECC would be told what<br>finance was available for the upcoming year. He said there was obviously an absence of<br>trust that needed to be resolved and if this could be overcome in<br>future years there could be a 2 or 3 year settlement so that monies<br>were promised much further in advance.  |  |

| 6. | <ul> <li>Report on Funded Schemes</li> <li>The Highway Liaison Officer gave the following updates on funded schemes <ul> <li>Item 1 on page 8 – Langley Lower Green 30mph speed limit. Objections had been received during the formal consultation period and therefore the scheme could not go ahead until these had been resolved. She explained that the objectors were written to and an explanation given, if they were not all cleared then the Cabinet Member had to approve through a slightly different legal process. This would now be considered for funding in the new financial year.</li> <li>In response to a query from Councillor Jones, the Highway Liaison Officer confirmed that no extra funding was required for number 4, Barnston road widening, and would hopefully be completed by the end of the financial year.</li> <li>Item 10 on page 9 – Great Chesterford to Saffron Walden cycleway. The design complexity had meant that this would not be considered for funding next year.</li> <li>Item 16 on page 9 - High Street, Saffron Walden, Tree Investigation, in response to a query from Councillor Gadd, the Highway Liaison Officer outside of the meeting.</li> <li>Item 25, page 11 - Quendon Village Traffic Calming, the Highway Liaison Officer said that this was unusual as the funding for the design and implementation had been agreed for the same year. |    | majority of the scheme would be implemented within this year and the final item would then be reviewed next year.   |  |
| 7. | Report on Schemes Awaiting Funding  |  |
|    | The Highway Liaison Officer had received a large quantity of<br>schemes leading up to Christmas and not all of them would be<br>validated by March. She said her recommendation would be to keep<br>some budget back for the June meeting and the Panel would then<br>need to prioritise which schemes were funded Some schemes had<br>already been agreed as priority 2 and these would be carried into the<br>new financial year: -<br>Item 4, Walden Road Hadstock Signage<br>Item 8, Wicken Bonhunt, Traffic Management Improvements<br>Item 10, Church Street, Saffron Walden, Bollards  |  |



In response to a query from Councillor Jones about Hoblongs Junction in Dunmow that he had put forward, the Highway Liaison Officer said this was being considered as an 'add on' to a casualty reduction scheme in a similar location. She said it would be sent back to Highways if it was not able to be considered through this route. Councillor Jones asked for it to be put on the awaiting funding scheme with a note added to this effect.

Councillor Sell asked about item 5 and 18 which related to Grove Hill in Stansted, the Highway Liaison Officer said that these schemes would be taken on by Jacobs and would be progressed by them as they had the expertise. There was also potential for 106 monies. She said the intention was to have the weight limit introduced to all areas of Stansted with the exception of the B1383 with the idea to produce a lorry ban throughout that area. This item would be discussed in the March meeting and there would be a public consultation which would last between 8 to 12 weeks. The cameras would not be installed straight away but would be part of a phased approach, as there was currently government legislation going through to allow this to happen.

The Chair said careful consideration needed to be given to this scheme in order to avoid the problem being moved to another area. He said it needed to be part of the consultation and alternative routes considered as other Parishes might have concerns.

Councillor Driscoll asked if Grove Hill could be prioritised before the rest of Stansted as he was concerned about the long delay while the whole scheme was introduced.

The Chair did not think Grove Hill could be separated off from the rest of the scheme.

Councillor Sell wondered if ECC could lobby the government about Grove Hill and ask them to speed up the legislation.

Councillor Barker suggested going through North Essex Parking Partnership (NEPP).

In response to a query from Councillor Barker who was concerned that the two casualty reduction schemes at Hoblongs and Braintree Road could on their own be more than the whole Highways budget. The Highway Liaison Officer said that these would be considered according to the number of incidents at a particular junction, which was calculated as the rate of return. She said this decided the value of the scheme against any potential savings from the implementation. If these schemes were over £500k they would become a major scheme but if they were lower the Panel would need to consider whether to fund them.

# UTTLESFORD LOCAL HIGHWAY PANEL REPORT 2 – SCHEMES AWAITING FUNDING

This Schemes Awaiting Funding List identifies those scheme requests, which have been received for the consideration of the Uttlesford Local Highways Panel (LHP). In February 2022 it was agreed, at ECC Full Council, that the 2022/23 Capital Budget for the twelve Local Highway Panels would include the previously agreed additional funding of £200,000.

It is also now the intention that Casualty Reduction Sites across the County are funded from a central pot of monies derived from the existing LHP funding allocations. This will reduce the overall yearly budget allocation to each Panel, as detailed in the summary below.

\* At the June 2021 Panel meeting members agreed to split £150,000 between LUTT203003 – Thaxted Road, Saffron Walden Cycleway (£100,000) and LUTT202005 – Quendon traffic calming (£50,000) with the figures adjusted as the designs were completed and cost estimates understood. The Quendon scheme was target costed as £80,000 so these figures have been adjusted accordingly. Members also previously identified some **Priority 2** schemes to bring into the programme if resources permitted. These are identified within the following reports in bold.

This Schemes Awaiting Funding List identifies all of the scheme requests that have been received for the future consideration of the Uttlesford Local Highways Panel.

There are currently schemes awaiting funding with an estimated cost of £197,700 with further value to be added upon the completion of feasibility studies, designs and validations.
