Dear Sir/Madam,

Further to previous correspondence dated 18<sup>th</sup> July 2022, we are writing to provide an update to current construction activities on Maypole Road.

As you will be aware, Maypole Road has been closed since 25<sup>th</sup> July 2022 whilst the new Staggered Junction alignment has been constructed to provide access to the future Relief Road between Langford Road and Broad Street Green.

Whilst the road has been closed, utility works have been completed (by others) from the junction with Langford Road to the new development site entrance to minimise the need for future closures and further disruption.

We are now in the process of laying the final asphalt layers to the carriageway and can confirm works are on course to enable the road to be re-opened to two-way traffic from 5<sup>th</sup> September 2022.

As there is a significant layout change to Maypole Road, we will be installing temporary traffic management on the carriageway to help road users navigate the new arrangement whilst we continue our works either side of the junction.

The temporary layout arrangement will be installed with temporary barriers and relevant signage to help guide all road users through the junction. We will also install advance warning signs to advise of the new road layout on approach.
