

Renewal of two traffic signal crossings, B1007 High Street, Billericay



Renewal of traffic signal crossings on B1007 High Street, Billericay

Arrangements have been made to replace two traffic signal crossings on B1007 High Street, Billericay.

The works will involve the removal of the old pelican crossing traffic signal equipment and its replacement with new puffin crossings. One is located outside the library and second by the junction of Alma Link.

Work is due to start on Monday 21 October 2019 and is anticipated to take approximately two weeks to complete.

To minimise congestion in the area, work will be carried out overnight between the hours of 7pm and 5am. During working hours, it will be necessary to have temporary lights in place to support lane closures that will be required to carry out the work in a safe manner. Traffic management will remain in place during the day to assist pedestrians crossing the road, but both lanes will be open to vehicles to keep traffic flowing.

Dates may be subject to change if affected by poor weather or if unexpected issues arise. The latest information will be reflected on site signage.
