Unfortunately the construction team have been unable to recover time lost earlier in the programme when utility diversions took longer than expected and additional work was required to the foundations and base slab design to overcome soft spots found during excavation. We anticipate with the current level of progress that the road will reopen at the end of April 2019. We regret the delay and will continue with our efforts to complete the works as safely and efficiently as possible.
