	All of the schemes on pages 7, 8 and 9 of the agenda highlighted in green were completed and the schemes not highlighted would either be completed in Q4 of 2021/22 or would slip into 2022/23.	
6.	Schemes Awaiting Funding 2022/23	РКК
	The HLO advised that the Schemes Awaiting Funding List identified those scheme requests which had been received for the consideration of the Epping Local Highways Panel (LHP). In February 2022 it was agreed, at ECC Full Council, that the 2022/23 Capital Budget for the twelve Local Highway Panels would include the previously agreed additional funding of £200,000.	
	It was also now the intention that Casualty Reduction Sites across the County would be funded from a central pot of monies derived from the existing LHP funding allocations. This would reduce the overall yearly budget allocation to each Panel, as detailed in the summary on page 10 of the agenda.	
	The Schemes Awaiting Funding list identified all the scheme requests which had been received for the consideration of the Epping Forest LHP.	
	There was a current estimated value of £782,500 for schemes awaiting funding with further value to be added upon the completion of validations and studies, which were already in the programme.	
	The breakdown of scheme types currently available for future consideration are detailed below:
